Here is what we are doing, please let us know if you have any questions:

- We are meeting under a tent in our backyard. We welcome you to walk around the building and join us there. We will meet from 10am until about 11:30am on Sunday.
 (If the weather prevents us from meeting outdoors, we will revert to our previous indoor service protocols. The biggest difference is masks are required indoors, unless on stage.)
- We will maintain 6 ft. at all times between non-household members.
- Please bring a mask to wear if case you find you are unable to stay 6ft. from others.
- Please bring your own chairs for seating if you choose not to sit in the pre-arranged seating under the tent.
- We are not yet able to share coffee or desserts or food of any sort.
- Please practice good hygiene, such as frequent hand disinfecting (provided), coughing in your elbow, refraining from hugging and handshaking.
- Enjoy being able to worship together and spend time with our dear church family!

Please take a few minutes to read and sign the following form. This will allow us to ensure the best possible experience for everybody as we reopen as a church. If you are unable to fulfill these requirements we will need you to wait to attend in person.

King of Grace Church Outdoor Worship Service Individual Requirements for Attendance:

days I will notify King of Grace Church immediately.

Church.

King of Grace Church Requirements

- No one who has either had known contact with COVID-19 or known contact with someone with COVID-19 in the
 past 14 days can attend.
- Those who are over 65 or at risk for COVID may attend at their own discretion.
- Attendees who are not part of the same immediate household will be seated at least 6 feet apart. Members of the same immediate household are permitted to sit together and be less than 6 feet apart
- If inside or less than 6 feet from non-household members, we will wear face coverings or masks at all times except where a person is unable to wear a face covering or mask because of a medical or disabling condition and except when leading in singing or preaching.
- For children between age 2 and 5, the wearing of a face covering or mask is at the discretion of the child's parent or guardian. Children under the age of 2 should not wear a face covering or mask
- Those on stage may remove their masks. If inside, they will sing and speak from behind a plexiglass shield.
- All in attendance will wash or disinfect their hands regularly and after touching any common surface or item. All will
 refrain from touching non-household members or their belongings.
- Communion elements will be prepared and distributed so only the recipient or their household comes in contact with the elements or their containers.
- Offering baskets will be placed at various locations for depositing contributions without contact by multiple people.
- The church building will be cleaned and disinfected between each service, including disinfection of heavy transit areas and high-touch surfaces (e.g., doorknobs, bathrooms, microphones, shared instruments)
- We will keep the building well-ventilated by employing methods like keeping windows open, running the HVAC continually and using Medical-Grade HEPA filtering.
- We will allow no more than 100 people in the back yard at a time, no more than 100 people in the Sanctuary at a time and no more than 75 people in the Hospitality Hall at a time.
- We will not have any eating of food on the premises until further notice.
- If we learn that an individual with COVID-19 attended a service or otherwise entered the place of worship, we will
 conduct a deep cleaning and disinfecting consistent with the Centers for Disease Control guidance and notify all
 attendees immediately.
